Head Start gives children from at-risk backgrounds the skills they need to be successful in school and life — supporting more kids, families, and communities on their path to success. My mother came to the United States with many hopes and dreams, working multiple entry-level jobs in order to give us a better life. She enrolled me in Head Start, a program that helped me learn social and communication skills, while preparing me to enter grade school. La Maestra Margot, my Head Start teacher, created an environment where I could safely learn my first words of English, learn through play, and pick up the necessary skills to thrive.

Having grown up in a predominantly agricultural town, in a lowincome household and raised by a single parent, the odds were stacked against me. Head Start helped me beat those odds by helping me gain confidence as a learner and giving me a teacher that became a lifelong mentor.

In 2012, I became the first person in my family to graduate from college — with a bachelor's degree in Animal Science from University of California, Davis. In 2018, I graduated with a Ph.D. in Biological and Biomedical Science from Cornell University. I am now a postdoctoral research scientist in New York City where I'm searching for new treatments for type 1 and type 2 diabetes.
